Conference presentations

A very important part of the network school is that all ESR's are expected to give lightning talks and present your individual research posters at the conference "Vattendagarna" (Thursday October 6). You have three minutes (sharp) for your talk, and after the oral session there will be a RIBES poster session with drinks. So please make sure to prepare the following before arriving in Karlstad:

- Prepare and send your PowerPoint (PPTX) presentations to olle.calles@kau.se before midnight Friday September 30! Your presentations will be combined in one large PPTX to minimize time required for change between speakers. Prepare and clock your talk (aim for 2 min 30 s)!
- Prepare and print your poster and bring it to Karlstad. Posters will be mounted on 700 mm wide bulletin boards, if you prefer you can bring a role-up instead.

It's up to you to decide on the outline of your talk and poster, focus on what you think the audience are interested in and what you think they should know about you and your research.

We will have access to the conference room for testing 17:00 – 18:00 hrs on October 5.

Getting to KAU

The university is located some 6 km from central Karlstad where the train station and most hotels are located. The easiest way to avoid a 1+ h walk is to take **Bus 1** from the main square ("Stora torget") to the university ("Universitetet"). Make sure to take the bus heading towards Uni = "Campus via Universitetet" and not the one heading in the opposite direction.
